Stanton City Commission Meeting

To the Commission and Citizens of Stanton,

We are making considerable progress on numerous projects and I am pleased to offer some updates:

1. The Parks and Recreation Plan draft document is currently available for public review at City Hall for a 30 day period. Once this period is complete we must hold a public hearing and take any final comments on the plan. This will be held directly before our first meeting in February, and barring any citizen comments which might lead to edits we will present the Commission with a resolution to adopt the plan. At this point we will be eligible to apply for our \$296,000 MNRTF grant, which ROWE is currently drafting.
2. We are continuing to attempt to clear the sidewalks of ice and snow, but due to the first storm accumulating significant ice on the pavement the DPW is having trouble clearing them completely. The crew has stayed on it with salt and are making every effort to make the walkways accessible.
3. You have in your packet the final artistic rendering of the park concept, which we will have on a large poster soon. This, along with the final overhead site design will be important tools as we attempt to solicit funds from private, less formalized foundation grant processes.
4. There are three bids in a "Single Hauler" folder in your DropBox that is separate from the packet. We will be considering several options, which include curbside recycling as opposed to the existing county program. The different options and pricing are laid out in the bids.
5. The next project on the docket I would like the Commission to consider is a redesign/rebuild of our City web page. It is quite outdated and receives minimal traffic. If properly utilized, we can create a valuable tool for the residents to find information and communicate with the City, and it can also be an excellent way for us to gather data and broadcast to our stakeholders.
