BRUSH, LIMB CHIPPING & LEAF BAG PICKUP GUIDELINES:

- Clear bags or brown paper bags with residents address written on them are acceptable.
- LEAVES ONLY. NO TRASH.
- Butt end of brush towards the road, less than 6" in diameter.
- Leaf vacuuming- leaves ONLY in the road, along the curb. If guidelines are not followed, your leaves/brush may not be picked up.
