Sec. 1-1. - Designation and citation of Code.

The ordinances embraced in this and the following chapters shall constitute and be designated the "Municipal Code of the City of Hometown, Wisconsin," and may be so cited. Such Code may also be cited as the "Algoma Code." The Code consists of parts I and II. Part I of this Code is a codification of general ordinances and part II of this Code is a codification of land use and land development ordinances; however:

- (1) The inclusion of provisions in part I that pertain to land use or land development does not excuse noncompliance with such provisions.
- (2) The inclusion of provisions in part II that do not pertain to land use or land development does not excuse noncompliance with such provisions.

Sec. 1-2. - Definitions and rules of construction.

The following definitions and rules of construction shall apply to this Code and to all ordinances, unless the context requires otherwise:

Generally.

- (1) If the provisions of different chapters of this Code conflict or contravene with each other, the provisions of each chapter shall prevail as to all matters and questions growing out of the subject matter of such chapter. When provisions conflict, the specific prevails over the general. All provisions shall be liberally construed so that the intent of the common council may be effectuated.
- (2) Words and phrases shall be construed according to the common and approved usage of the language, but technical words, technical phrases and words and phrases that have acquired peculiar and appropriate meanings shall be construed according to such meanings.
- (3) Provisions shall be interpreted and applied so as to be the minimum requirements adopted for the promotion of the public health, safety, comfort, convenience and general welfare.
- (4) Grammatical errors shall not vitiate, and a transposition of words and clauses may be resorted to when the sentence or clause is without meaning as it stands.

Acts by agents. When a provision requires an act to be done that may legally be done by an agent, such requirement includes all such acts when done by an authorized agent.

City. The term "city" means the City of Algoma, Kewaunee County, Wisconsin.
